UNIFORM POLICY ENFORCEMENT

Dear Parents and Legal Guardians:

This letter is to inform you that as of **Tuesday, September 6, 2016**, the uniform policy will be strictly enforced. As you may know, Central High School is consistently making improvements in order to better serve your child to compete with neighboring schools and in order to ensure increased student achievement. Parents we need your support and partnership in order to ensure that your child will be prepared, equipped and dressed in the appropriate attire for **out-of-the-classroom experiences, internships and other field opportunities** that is in accordance with our new school mission and vision.

Below is a list of the required items needed so your child will not be in violation with the school uniform policy. All violations of the uniform policy will result in corrective action outlined in the discipline policy. **EVERY MONDAY, TUESDAY, AND WEDNESDAY OF EACH WEEK ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR THE CHS BLAZER, AND ON THURSDAY AND FRIDAY STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR POLO SHIRTS.**

***BLAZERS ARE NECESSARY BECAUSE WE ARE INCREASING OUR OFF SITE INTERNSHIPS AND COMMUNITY SERVICE OPPORTUNITIES. THUS, OUR STUDENTS MUST DRESS PROFESSIONAL.**

1. All students must wear a white or sky blue button up collar shirt (**NO POLO SHIRTS**) that has a CHS logo from **Monday – Wednesday**.
2. All students must wear neck ties from **Monday - Wednesday**.
3. All students must wear a navy CHS blazer, navy V-Neck pullover sleeveless Oxford sweater vest or a navy and white button up sweater with the CHS logo. **NO OTHER OUTER GARMENTS WILL BE ACCEPTABLE.** Hoodies are not allowed.
4. All students must wear **HARD BOTTOM SHOES/BOOTS OR SOFT BOTTOM CASUAL SHOES** (ex. loafers or hush puppies).
5. All students must wear khaki pants only. **CARGO PANTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.**
6. Girls are allowed to wear uniform dresses with CHS logo, uniform skirts (see below) and/or khaki pants.
7. All students must purchase the gym uniforms and get dressed every day.
