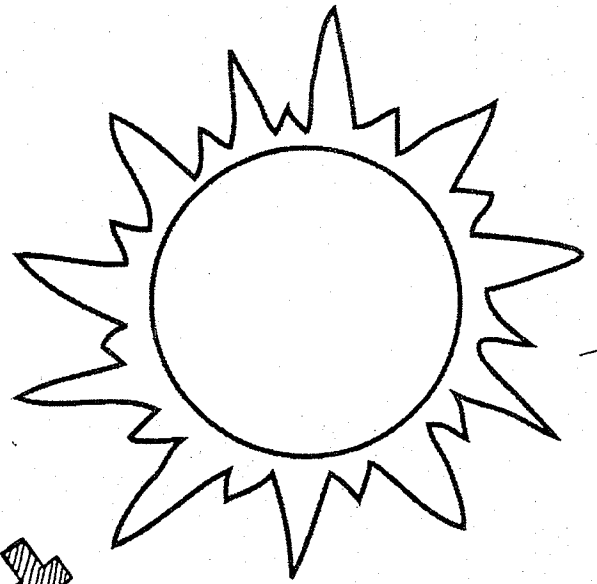
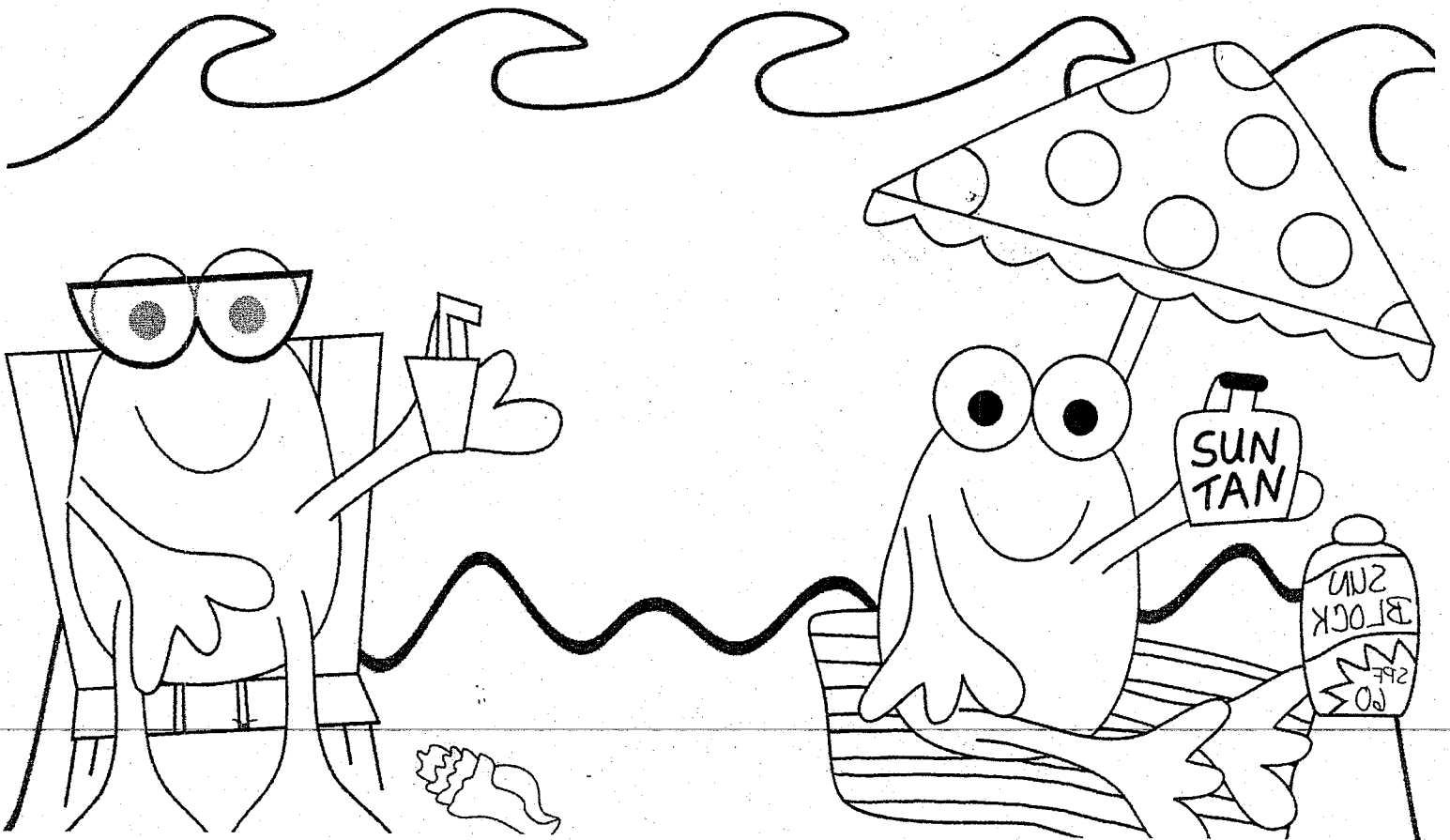

 - Keep a notebook as a writing journal so that 2-3 times a week your child can write about their summer.
