LEARN: Gain proven techniques that you can use the next day in the classroom, taught by champion teacher-professors.




PRACTICE: Record yourself practicing core techniques, and then receive feedback from peers and professors.




PERFORM: Become a whiz at analyzing student data, and then demonstrate your ability to drive academic growth.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Summer I	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 1-week Teaching Fundamentals intensive • Online modules
Fall/Spring I	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 weeknights/month of Core classes • 1 Saturday/month of Content classes • 40% Core + Content through online modules

The program has three academic terms—summer, fall, and spring—which include the following components:

- **Core:** General pedagogy instruction and concrete teaching skills
- **Content:** Techniques specific to grade levels and subjects
